Declaring "Ann Kirven Day"

WHEREAS, A. Ann Kirven was hired by the Clarendon County Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse board on March 28, 1975 as its first Executive Director; and

WHEREAS, A. Ann Kirven holds a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from the University of South Carolina, a Master of Education in Rehabilitative Counselling from the University of South Carolina and a Master of Arts in Management of Organizations from Central Wesleyan College; and

WHEREAS, A. Ann Kirven has guided the Clarendon County Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse agency (now re-named Clarendon Behavior Health Services) for 40 years to become a pre-eminent behavioral counseling facility in the State of South Carolina as well as a leader in the field of diagnosis, treatment and guidance for substance abuse issues; and

WHEREAS, A. Ann Kirven has served as a statewide leader and as an ambassador for Clarendon County in countless state boards and committees to champion the cause of behavior health services and the need for treatment and education on the dangers of substance abuse; and


WHEREAS, A. Ann Kirven has been a lifelong resident of Clarendon County and has brought honor and distinction to Clarendon County.
