**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF
THE COUNTY OF CLARENDON, SOUTH CAROLINA BALLOT
QUESTION IN THE GENERAL ELECTION OF
NOVEMBER 8, 2016**

WHEREAS, a County Election was held in Clarendon County, South Carolina on the 8th day of November 2016;

WHEREAS, in addition to the General Election held on November 8, 2016, the following referendum question appeared on the ballot:

Shall the South Carolina Department of Revenue be authorized to issue temporary permits in this county for a period not to exceed twenty-four hours to allow the possession, sale, and consumption of alcoholic liquors by the drink to bona fide nonprofit organizations and business establishments authorized to be licensed for consumption-on-premises sales and to allow the sale of beer and wine at permitted off-premises locations without regard to the days or hours of sales?


WHEREAS, the Clarendon County Voter Registration and Elections Board has duly certified the ballots cast to County Council for the purpose of having the results canvassed and declared.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that at said election there were cast 12,100 ballots tabulated as follows for the subject County of Clarendon, South Carolina Ballot Question:


In favor of the question 7,435
Opposed to the question 4,665

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the majority of the 12,100 voters voted in favor of the subject question, thereby authorizing the South Carolina Department of Revenue to issue temporary permits in this county for a period not to exceed twenty-four hours to allow the possession, sale, and consumption of alcoholic liquors by the drink to bona fide nonprofit organizations and business establishments authorized to be licensed for consumption-on-premises sales and to allow the sale of beer and wine at permitted off-premises locations without regard to the days or hours of sales.
