It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Clarendon County Sheriff's Office to provide animal control services for the County of Clarendon in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of South Carolina and locally established policies, regulations and ordinances.


Section Five:

Severability-should any section, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section Six:

Conflicting Ordinances- all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance or inconsistent with its provisions are hereby repealed or superseded to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.
