



## Clarendon County Special Called Meeting Tuesday, March 25, 2014, 9:00 AM Council Chambers

Chairman Stewart called the meeting to order at 9:00 am and led the invocation. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited in unison.

### I. Requests

1. Administrator Epperson presented Council with a request to waive all fees associated with the Courthouse Renovation Project and the DSS, Coroner and Probation Parole and Pardon Services Facility Construction. He stated that all fees were waived for the construction of the Administration Building as well. Administrator Epperson stated that this would eliminate ten to fifteen thousand dollars of building permit fees.

Chairman Stewart asked Administrator Epperson does The City of Manning have any fees?

Administrator Epperson responded by stating no. He stated that the County has an agreement with The City of Manning.

On motion by Councilman English, and seconded by Vice Chairman Frierson, Council voted Unanimous Approval to waive all fees associated with the Renovation Projects of the County Courthouse, the Coroner and Probation Parole and Pardon Services Facility, and the Construction of the DSS Building.

2. Administrator Epperson presented Council with a request to accept the resignation of Mr. Bon Gardner, from the Zoning Board of Appeals and to appoint Mr. Bon Gardner to the Clarendon County Assessment Board of Appeals.

Administrator Epperson concluded by stating that, if approved, this appointment term would run from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014.

On motion by Vice Chairman Frierson and seconded by Councilman Richardson, Council voted Unanimous Approval to accept the resignation of Mr. Bon Gardner.

On Motion by Councilman Richardson, and seconded by Vice Chairman Frierson, Council voted Unanimous Approval to appoint Mr. Bon Gardner to the Clarendon County Assessment Appeals Board.


