RESOLUTION 2012-06

WHEREAS, Clarendon County desires to encourage equal opportunity housing for all its citizens; and

WHEREAS, to insure fair housing opportunities for all its citizens, Clarendon County has passed a Fair Housing Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Clarendon County further wishes to bring to the attention of its citizens its concern that all citizens are informed and aware of their rights under the State of South Carolina Fair Housing Law of 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Act ensures that every person regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability, or familial status can obtain housing. The Act also promotes the establishment of safe and secure communities where everyone, regardless of nationality, can live free from discrimination; and

WHEREAS, Clarendon County wishes to encourage realtors, churches and other civic organizations to be aware and sensitive to the needs of all citizens of Clarendon County in regard to their rights and housing opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Clarendon County Council hereby proclaims April 2012 as Fair Housing Month in Clarendon County.
