

An emergency meeting of the Clarendon County Council was called to order on Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup> at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Dwight Stewart. The meeting was conducted via a telephone conference call. The purpose of the meeting was to declare a state of emergency and a curfew in Clarendon County as a result of unprecedented rain storms on October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup>. Those attending the meeting were Councilman A. C. English and Vice Chair, W. J. Frierson. Chairman Stewart declared that a quorum was present. He asked for a motion to declare the state of emergency and the curfew to run from 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup> until 7:00 a.m. each day through Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>. Without further action from the Council, the curfew would expire at 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>.

The motion was made by Vice Chair Frierson to impose the curfew in Clarendon County. The motion was seconded by Councilman English. The motion was passed unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
