



ELECTRONICS (E-WASTE) COLLECTION

Starting November 6, 2010, Clarendon County will be accepting E-Waste at the Clarendon County Landfill on the first and third Saturday of each month between the hours of 9 am and 3 pm, except those months when we do a county-wide recycling event. This service will be free to all Clarendon County Residents.

This service is available only at the county landfill, located at 2475 J. W. Rhames Road in Manning. Please do not drop off E-Waste at our other recycling centers.

Businesses with E-Waste are asked to contact Madaline Braxton, Clarendon County Recycling Coordinator, at 803-435-9384 to make arrangements for proper disposal of their E-Waste.

ACCEPTED ITEMS

Personal Computers (PC's), Monitors, LCD Screen/Flat Screen Monitors, VCRs, Radios, Stereos, DVD Players, Microwaves, Power Supplies, Rechargeable Batteries, Vacuums, Banking Equipment, Telephones, Pagers, Networking Equipment, Laptops, Keyboards, Mice, Power Cables, Medical Equipment (Non-Hazardous), Printers, Copy Machines, Fax Machines, Cell Phones, Transformers, Scanners, Portable Electronic Devices, Servers, HUBS, Ink Cartridges, Toner Cartridges, Remotes, Modems, Projectors, Cameras, Televisions.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

Refrigerators, Washing Machines, Clothes Dryers, Dish Washers, Mercury Containing Devices (Thermometers, Fire Alarms), Hazardous Chemicals/Materials, Light Bulbs, Florescent Tubes, Bio-Waste.
